

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Regulations Guidelines

The privilege of driving to school is extended to students who have valid driver's licenses. Please see Mrs. Travis in the Main Office with this **form**, as well as your **license, registration, and insurance**. You will choose a parking space and will be given a parking tag that must face outward on your rear-view mirror so that it is clearly visible every day.

2024 SENIORS: You will be given priority and may return this form beginning on August 23, 2023. Underclassmen may return this form starting September 1, 2023 before or after school, or during lunch period.

Only vehicles with permit tags may park in the lot. Students who fail to obtain one will be subject to disciplinary consequences as assigned by an administrator. Driving privileges may be suspended or revoked by an administrator if the student is habitually in violation of any school expectations. Those whose privileges have been revoked are subject to suspension.

Student Expectations

- Students may park only in the student parking, located behind the auditorium and the Athletic lot outside of the Fieldhouse. Vehicles may not park on any grassy areas, along driveways, or in spaces that are marked "reserved". Students will be given a **designated space**. Failure to use that space will result in loss of their parking space and parking tag.
- Vehicles may not be used during the school day unless given permission by an administrator. All vehicles may be subject to search by Administration if there is reasonable suspicion of illegal content or activities.
- Students are not allowed to sit in cars in the morning before school starts, or during the school day.

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
